Icebreaker:

1. What is the strangest place that you have visited? Would you go back?
2. What is your favorite travel story?

Summary:

Rahab's story reveals to us that reminders matter. Why? Because it was through the tangible reminders of the stories she heard, and the scarlet rope she held, that her perspective was shifted to see God's power and kindness and filled her with His courage and hope along the way.

Engage the Bible:

Joshua 2:1-24 - Open your Bibles to Joshua 2:1-24 and read as a group. **Underline some key words/phrases that stand out to you. What are your thoughts about Rahab's actions in this passage? If you were in Rahab's position, would you have helped the spies? Or would you have responded to Jericho by bringing out the men who entered her house?**

Small Group Questions:

- Share a story from your own life or from someone else's experience that displayed God's power or kindness. How did that story impact you?
- What is a tangible reminder (like the scarlet rope) that helps you remember God's character? What characteristic of God does it remind you of?
- Just as God invited Rahab to play a pivotal role in His story, how do you feel God is inviting you to participate in His work today? Are there any specific actions or decisions you feel called to make?
