Icebreaker:

- 1. What movie has the best soundtrack?
- 2. What song would be the anthem of your life?

Summary:

The story of Adam and Eve is not just an ancient history lesson. It's our beginning, our end and our whole story. God the Father, Jesus, holy spirit, Satan, sin, brokenness, redemption are not just characters in the story of the Garden. This is the story of our relationship with all of God, and the first hint at the good news that Jesus would redeem the brokenness of our fallen world. God intended and still desires to live in direct relationship with us.

Engage the Bible:

Genesis 3:15-24 - Read as a group. Can you see the first glimpse of God's plan to save humanity from their sin? What do you think about God keeping us out of the Garden? Was it mean or gracious? Would you have come up with a different plan?

Small Group Questions:

- Share a story of doing something, (like eating a whole batch of cookie dough) that you knew you were not supposed to do.
- Why do you suppose we do things we are told not to do, even if we know the consequences could be terrible?
- If you were Adam or Eve, would you have eaten from the tree of knowledge of good and evil?
- How does it make you feel that God created you special out of all the creation? What is your response to that?
- Read John 8:44, John 10:10, 1 John 3:8, Revelation 12:9 and rev 21:10. Do these reveal anything new to you? Do you believe Satan is a real entity? Why or why not?
