



**Have someone read this section of Isaiah out loud.**

**Isaiah 40:10-14** See, the Sovereign Lord comes with power, and he rules with a mighty arm.  
See, his reward is with him, and his recompense accompanies him.

He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young.

Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?

Who can fathom the Spirit of the Lord, or instruct the Lord as his counselor?  
Whom did the Lord consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way?  
Who was it that taught him knowledge, or showed him the path of understanding?

### **Conversation Starters**

1. Do Biblical comparisons of God with things in our lives (ie. a father, a shepherd, a light) help or hinder your understanding of God?

4. If you had to “explain” God to someone how would you begin?
5. What might change in your life or faith if you had a bigger vision of God?
